

A. Protection

We run a dog shelter where we receive abandoned animals and those which are rescued by the defence area of our organization. The shelter also serves as an example of how an animal can be well kept economically. Once they are spayed/neutered, vaccinated and wormed, they are put up for adoption. This process implies an interview with the prospective owner, a visit to the potential home, and if the adoption goes through, three follow-up visits.

Our defence area responds to reports of mistreatment and negligence. Emphasis is given to educating those responsible for negligence so they learn how to treat their animals better. If necessary, we exercise our legal right to remove the animal from its owner. This same procedure is applied for abused horses.
